Congratulations to Jane Bush, Merril Kerss, Bette Jones and Mel Spence for gaining a position on the Ladies Selection Committee.

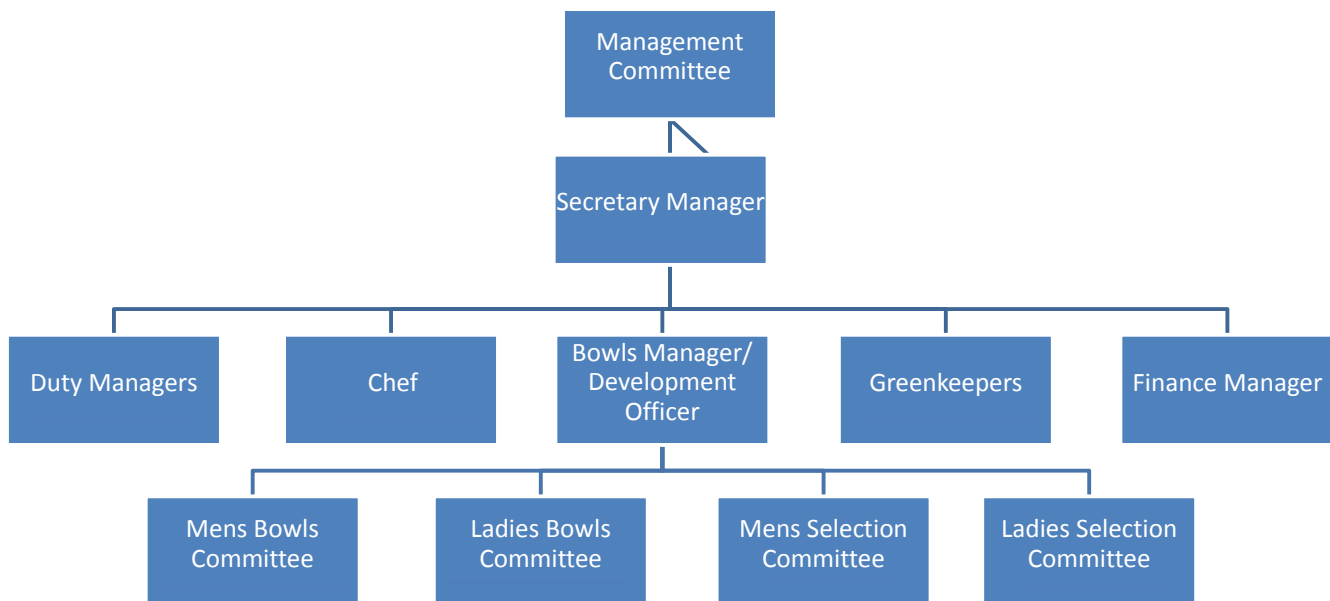

The organisational structure, shown below, was recommended by a sub committee and endorsed by the Management Committee. The structure provides the opportunity for members to nominate for positions where they feel they can have a positive input and help develop the bowls section of the club.

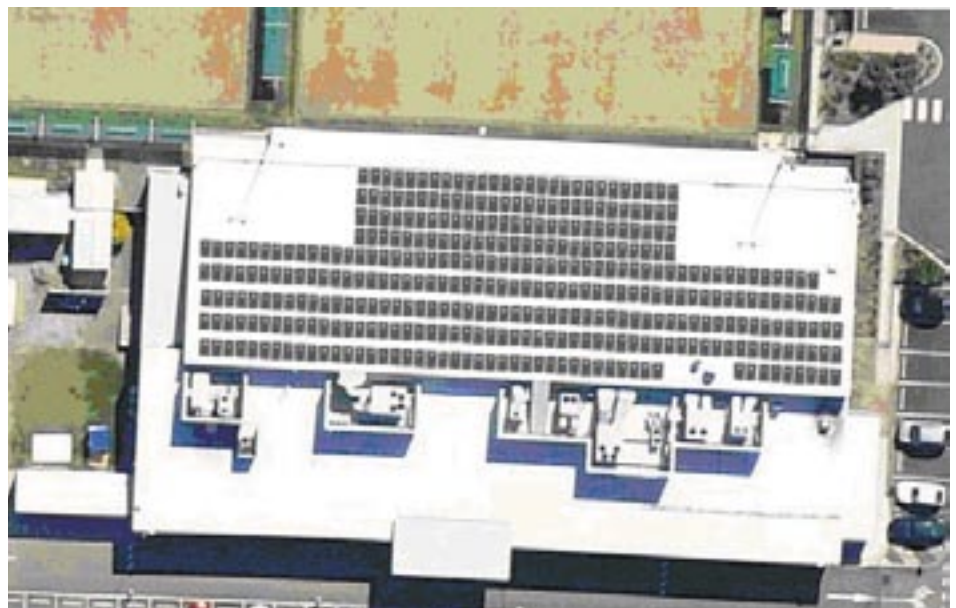


Each Bowls Committee will comprise of Bowls Manager (Chairman) and 4 Members elected at Bowls Section AGM. (Joint meetings will be all of each gender. Term of appointment 1st May – 30 April)

Each Selection Committee will comprise of Bowls Manager (Chairman)
 2 Selectors appointed by the Bowls Manager
 2 Selectors elected by the Bowling Members at Bowls Section AGM.
 Term of appointment – 1st May – 30th April

Going Solar At the May meeting for bowling members the vote for the purchase and installation of a solar energy system for the club was almost unanimous.

Australian Solar Power Consultants conducted an extensive analysis of the club’s electricity consumption patterns. From this analysis and the club’s roof size they have recommend that the club install A 100KW system which will provide around half of the daily requirements. The nett cost after GST for the purchase and installation will be \$100,000. After allowing for the GST Refund, a cost recovery period of approximately five years has been estimated. This represents a return on Investment of 20% pa.
